- 3. 2021-22 Membership & Participation
- 21 schools attended at least one event
- 16 paid dues. Jen expects to collect dues from 4 more schools
- Probable dropouts = Ethel Walker, JFK, and Poulson
- Saxe in New Canaan has a dad who is trying to start a team
- John Rook offered to help a teacher at JFK in Enfield take over from Janice Cerrino who is retiring

4. 2022-23 Events

In person, virtual or both?

- If the covid situation in October is the same as it is now, we'll have in person events.
- Jen will send coaches a survey a month before our October tournament asking coaches if their school will attend in person, virtually, or both.
- If there's enough demand, we'll offer virtual tournaments on the same days as our in-person tournaments. This means CTMSDL needs to staff 2 tournaments on the same day. CDA has been doing this for a long time. We want to keep debate accessible to as many kids as possible.
- If online tournaments are large enough, they won't skew who qualifies for the Championship. This could be a problem if online tournaments are tiny.
- Some coaches felt the quality of speeches went down online with more kids reading than when we were in person.
 Some coaches feel online and in person debating are totally different skills.
 - Some coaches want students to get comfortable debating online because being comfortable in online meetings is a good skill.
- We discussed possibility of combining in-person and remote debating IF schools have the technology to bring virtual debaters into classrooms. Coaches whose schools can host should find out if their school is capable of that.

Online balloting

- We'd like to continue to use online ballots at in-person tournaments.
- Some coaches know their schools' Guest wifi won't allow a lot of guests. Others thought their schools' wifi could handle it.
- Schools that can host tournaments should check with their IT staff. We'll need up to 60 people able to use Guest wifi.

Recruiting and training judges for in person tournaments.

- We'll probably need to use parents as judges when in person
- We'll offer online judge training workshops a couple of weeks before tournaments. Jennifer Hunt & Josephine Shea will host.

5. Schedule for 2022-23

Dates

- April and May tournaments are difficult because debaters and judges have too many conflicts.
- The October 2022 event will be a regular tournament for Open Level debaters. Novice debaters will watch a demo debate during R1, analyze it during R2, scrimmage R3.

Coaches liked the Equity presentations and procedures with 2 exceptions – emails need to explain issues more explicitly so coaches know exactly what happened/ what was said, and issues need to be discussed on tournament day or very soon after as it's much more difficult to deal with 2 days later.

- Jen, Jennifer Hunt & Josephine Shea will develop written policies and procedures and pledge over the summer.
- Jen apologized for dropping the ball on the Pledge & written Equity Policies and Procedures.
- Several coaches believe we had more smirking, laughing and eye rolling when we debated online. A CDA debater said this has been true at the High School level too. Coaches and Equity need to remind debaters of general equity principles.


